**PARISH REGISTRATION:** We welcome new parishioners to share fully in our Parish life. As new members you bring vitality and growth to our parish. Registration forms are available in the clear magazine racks in each of the entrances of the Church. You may call the Parish Office to have a registration form mailed to you or stop by and complete a registration form at the Parish Office. You may also use the Parish web site <a href="mailto:iopnc.org">iopnc.org</a> to register online, **please call to confirm that your online registration was received**.

**BAPTISM:** Parental Attendance at a Preparation Class for the first child to be baptized is mandatory. The Baptism class takes place at 1:30PM in the Parish Hall on the last Sunday of the month and in Spanish on the 1st Wednesday of the month at 7PM in the Library of the Parish Hall. If you are requesting the baptism be in Spanish you will be required to attend the Spanish Baptism Instruction Class. Pre-registration is not required. To have your child baptized you must meet the following requirements (1) be a registered parishioner for at least three months (2) be practicing the faith (3) have obtained the signed Godparent Eligibility form and returned them to the Parish Office. Please check the bulletin monthly for possible changes of class dates. Parents planning to have children baptized in the near future can contact the Parish Office in advance to obtain Godparent Eligibility Forms, these forms will need to be returned to the Parish Office before any baptism date will be scheduled.

**MARRIAGE**: Arrangements must be made with a Parish Priest at least six months before your requested date. To be married at Infant of Prague you must be a registered member of our Parish for at least six months.

# OCIA & SACRAMENTAL PREPARATION FOR ADULTS

Thank you for your continued prayers!!! On Sunday, September 8th, we kicked off the OCIA\* sessions at IOP with 53 people in attendance!

\*OCIA, the **Order of Christian Initiation of Adults**, (previously known as *Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults* = RCIA) is a process that assists adults into full acceptance into the Catholic Church. A team of experienced lay catechists facilitates this process of growth in the individual. People who might be interested in this process are those who have recognized a call from God for greater union with Him and desire to fulfill this call. The process is structured to provide for a variety of individual backgrounds:

- unbaptized with no experience in any church
- unbaptized with some familiarity with a church or worship community
- baptized in the Catholic or other recognized Christian church who have no church experience
- baptized Catholics who have received First Holy Communion but have never been Confirmed
- baptized in other churches who are very familiar with the life of Christ
- those who are married to Catholics and now desire to profess the Catholic faith

OCIA Sessions at IOP are held on Sundays from 12:15~1:30PM in the Parish Hall, until May 18th, 2025. This is the schedule for the coming weeks:

- September 15th: "God's Longing for Man; Man's Longing for God > Basic Salvation History (The Fall)"
- September 22nd: "Who is Jesus Christ?"
- \*\*\*NO OCIA session on September 29th but we invite you to check out the Eucharistic Miracles Exhibit in the Parish Hall that weekend.






